

Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?” 5 Jesus answered, “Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God. 6 That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit. 7 Do not marvel that I said to you, ‘You must be born again.’ 8 The wind blows where it wishes, and you hear its sound, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes. So it is with everyone who is born of the Spirit.”

9 Nicodemus said to him, “How can these things be?” 10 Jesus answered him, “Are you the teacher of Israel and yet you do not understand these things? 11 Truly, truly, I say to you, we speak of what we know, and bear witness to what we have seen, but you do not receive our testimony. 12 If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how can you believe if I tell you heavenly things? 13 No one has ascended into heaven except he who descended from heaven, the Son of Man. 14 And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, 15 that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.

16 “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

Sermon

“Heaven’s Math”

Pastor Dan Storvick

Simple math: $1 + 1 + 1 = 3$. Any first grader knows that.

Heaven's Math: We know the mystery of $1 + 1 + 1 = 1$. We are Trinitarian Christians. Though we worship the One True God, we see, know and experience God in three distinct Persons: God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit.

The First Article (*Congregation recites*)

I. I believe in God the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth

In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth (Gen.1:1).

His plans: *I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future" (Jeremiah 29:11).*

His purpose: *Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart (Jeremiah 1:5).*

His Promise: *I formed you; you are my servant; O Israel, you will not be forgotten by me (Isiah 44:21).*

Can a woman forget her nursing child, that she should have no compassion on the son of her womb? Even these may forget, yet I will not forget you (Isaiah 49:15).

Is the Holy Spirit God?

Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit . . . You have not lied to man but to God." (Acts 5:3-4).

Don't you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in you? (1 Cor 3:16).

Through the Holy Spirit, we are . . .

But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light (1 Peter 2:9).

Gifted: Given a special job and a special ability to complete the job.

A spiritual gift is given to each of us so we can help each other (1 Cor 12:7).

Grown: Sanctified is the word the Bible uses. It means being set apart for what God intended you to be when he first thought of you.

But you were washed, you were sanctified, you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and by the Spirit of our God (1 Corinthians 6:11).

But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you (John 14:26).

But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Peter 3:18).
